

Robin's Discover Enquiry – What is Special about me?

Sticky Knowledge

Everyone has something that makes them special. Some people are great at drawing, singing, cooking or making things. Others are good friends, great at counting or fantastic at writing. This term we will be learning about what makes us special.

We will also be learning about things you have done in the past (such as birthday celebrations, visiting new places and seeing family) and how toys have changed over time.

Answer these questions to help you keep your knowledge sticky (to really remember things we have learnt!)

Who is in my family? What do I like to do? What am I good at? What are my friends good at? What makes me the same/ different to other people?

Key Vocabulary	Definitions
Special	Better, greater or different to usual.
Same & Different	Two things that have similarities (have things that are the same)/ differences (may look, feel, taste, smell or sound different.)
Past	A time before now. It has already happened.

How to help at home:

Talk about how things have changed in your child's life. This could include talking about how a room in your house has changed after being redecorated or speaking about a trip or holiday you have been on. Using photos is a great way to do this.

You could also talk about what toys you/your child's grandparents used to play with as a child and how these are different from the toys your child has today.

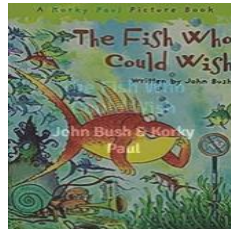
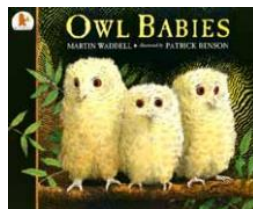
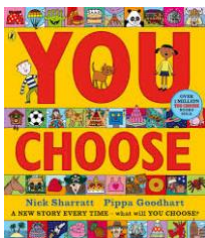
