


Maths

This term our focus will be on place value. We will be reading, writing and representing numbers to up to 10,000; finding more or less than a number and comparing numbers.

We will move on to mental and written methods of addition and subtraction.



English

To start our English off this term we will be looking at stories that show changes in every day life and using these stories as inspiration for our own class book.

We will be doing some role play, writing a diary entry and making instructions for a tasty seasonal recipe.

History

We will be comparing the life—and death— of the Ancient Egyptians and people in the Neolithic period and questioning what is the same, what is different and the reasons why.

Drawing on previous knowledge, we will build up our chronological knowledge and order events on a timeline.



We will consider what evidence has been left behind and look at ways we can learn from this.

PE

We will be keeping our bodies and minds fit with Athletics and Yoga with Mrs McCaffrey.



Art/DT

We will have a go at writing our own messages in Neolithic symbols and Egyptian Hieroglyphs as well as making Stone Age jewellery and Egyptian amulets.



Science

In our 'Animals including humans' topic this term, we will be learning about teeth and human digestion.

We will:

- identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans
- construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
