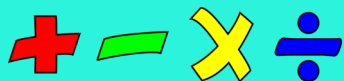


Maths

After briefly revisiting place value and addition and subtraction, we will be multiplying and dividing. Starting with times tables, up to 12x12 and the corresponding division facts, we will move on to multiplying and dividing upto 3-digit numbers by 1-digit number.



English

This term our focus is stories and non-chronological reports. We will be learning about the features, structure and language of different genres of stories or information text available and, when writing our own examples, our focus will be on appropriate vocabulary and the audience it is aimed at.



Geography

In our explore topic we will think about where in the world we would like to go. We will be using maps and atlases to locate countries, major cities and key physical features.

We will build on our locational knowledge by learning about the earth's equator, hemispheres, longitude and latitude, time zones and the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn.



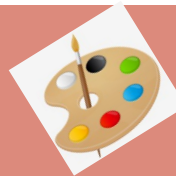
PE

In art this term we will be recording our observational drawings in our sketchbooks using pencil, charcoal and paint with our focus being on the natural world.



Science

In our Living things and their habitats topic this term, we will be exploring and learning to use classification keys to identify and name a variety of living things in the local and wider environment.

We will be looking at how living things thrive in their environments and learning about the impact changes in environment can have.

During our investigations some of the scientific skills we will be focussing on include observation, fair testing, collecting data and measuring.
