This term I will learn to:

Communication and Language Development

This term I will learn to:

Focus my attention and listen to instructions whilst being involved in an activity.

Follow directions (if not intently focused on own choice of activity).

Respond to simple instructions.

Understand 'why' and 'how' questions and begin to respond appropriately.

Physical Development

This term I will learn to:

Travel with confidence and skill around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment.

Use simple tools to effect changes to materials.

Become more confident when using scissors.

Be able to attend to own some of my own physical needs (going to the toilet when needed; getting a drink when thirsty or taking off a jumper when feeling hot.)

Literacy

This term I will learn to:
