

Brookland CE Primary School Uniform Policy

Our school uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of our school. Our uniform and logo act as a visual reminder of our school Christian vision, values and expectation. We ask that respect and support our policy and in doing so ensure that your child comes to school wearing the correct, clean school uniform and that the children take pride in their personal appearance.

Aims of our School Uniform.

- To be a visual representation of our school Christian vision and values;
- To promote a sense of pride in the school;
- To engender a feeling of community and belonging;

We have thought carefully about our school uniform and have chosen it to be smart, reflective of our vision, comfortable and practical for primary aged children. We have also looked at making it as affordable to families as possible.

In order to do this the **sweatshirt/cardigan is the only piece of school uniform that we ask for the logo to be present.**

School Uniform

Red sweatshirt or cardigan (ideally with the Brookland Logo)
Red/White Polo shirt
Grey skirt/pinafore dress/trousers or shorts
Grey tights/White Socks or grey socks
Black shoes (low heels) or plain black leather trainers (no logos)
Book Bag
A waterproof coat

Red Fleece (Optional, with or without Logo) – these are usually for outdoors but children are allowed to wear them in colder weather indoors.

Alternative uniform for warmer weather

- Grey shorts
- Red/White gingham dress with white socks

During the summer months we ask that children bring a hat to school and have sunscreen applied before coming in the morning

PE Kit – this can be worn to school on the designated day.

- Plain red polo shirt/T shirt (A logo shirt can be worn if preferred)
- Black Shorts
- Black Plimsoles or trainers
- Plain Black Tracksuit. (cotton not nylon – please see below)

Woodland@Brookland

- A pair of named wellington boots (to be kept at school)
- For use of the fire pit children **should not** wear nylon tracksuits as they are highly flammable.

Pre-Loved Uniform

We accept donations of pre-loved uniform. Please visit the school office where the staff will be able to help.

Hats/Hair Coverings

Children may not wear hats, caps, handkerchiefs, bandanas, scarves, or other head coverings indoors at school. Exceptions can be made for religious/or medical reasons.

Hair

Hair should be neat, brushed and tied back if long. Pupils should avoid tramlines, dyed elements, Mohicans or similar. Oversized head bands and bows should also be avoided.

Piercings

Ear-rings if worn must only be small studs and either be removed by the child or left at home on PE days. Facial piercings are not permitted.

Necklaces/Chains/Watches

Necklaces and chains are not permitted. Watches can be worn but must be removed by the children for sporting activities. Smart Watches or those that take photographs should not be worn to school.

Shoes

All shoes should be black, with a low heel. To help reduce costs – plain black leather trainers can be worn (No visible logos). Winter boots should be ankle length, no higher. No fabric, fur or suede type material should be worn to school.

Hands/Nails/Make Up

Children may not wear bracelets, armbands or rings. Nails should be free of any artificial enhancements (varnish, acrylic, silk wraps, press-on, rhinestones etc.) Make up is not permitted.
